### Scope of the project

Increased household food production at household or community level focusing on grain, vegetables, poultry, piggery and beekeeping initiatives

Aggregation of a minimum of 20 – 100 household gardens, small scale poultry and piggery projects including beekeeping projects

Production at required scale, thus enabling them to store, process, package and sell surplus produce

Assist in establishing a food hub in a community

To improve the contribution of the province to Food and Nutrition Security in South Africa

### **Qualifying Criteria**

South African citizens or locally based Community Development Organizations with a footprint in the Eastern Cape.

Cooperatives, Traditional Councils, Schools, Clinics, NPOs, NGOs and CBOs.

Locally based Non-Governmental Organizations or Not-for-profit organizations and individuals interested in the upliftment of vulnerable households.

Ability to aggregate a minimum of 20-100 gardens within a 5km radius to put under

Comprehensive proposal that demonstrates financial and technical capacity
Clear job creation plan
Copy/ies of Identity Documents for all applicants/beneficiaries
Copy business registration / Legal Entity Status
Regulatory authorizations

#### **Exclusion Criteria**

Non-South African Nationals or Citizens Not having land or legitimate land use right;

Non-Compliance with South African laws applicable to any farm operations; Farms owned or leased by government official or immediate family member/s or holding public office in national, provincial and local government;
